

Education Stabilization Funding for Unfinished Learning

Both The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSA) and The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) describe multiple ways that school districts can use pandemic funds to address unfinished learning.
